6. Shaen shared, "Sharing your life with other people and doing life together isn't uniquely Christian until it's tied to the gospel and our faith in Jesus". How does this statement challenge you?
7. What fears, concerns, excitement, or joy come to mind when you think about joining and doing life with a small group?
8. How might FCOG look different if we were truly a community that shared life AND the gospel together?
9. Read Phillipians 1:6...what encouragement can we glean from these confident words of Paul?
