Discussion Questions

What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or your consideration of Jesus' resurrection?

- 1. The Resurrection is one of the foundational pieces of Christianity. If that is removed, if Jesus would have stayed dead and buried in the tomb, the whole thing falls apart.
 - Why is that the case?
 - Can you think of Scriptures that address that?
- 2. Have you ever had a discussion with someone outside the faith about the resurrection? How did that go?
- 3. How often do you think about Jesus' resurrection? How would you say it either helps or hinders your faith?
- 4. The sermon declared that Jesus' resurrection is THE solution:
 - · Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life
 - Death could not hold Him down
 - Jesus died that we might live
 - · Jesus invites us into the life of light: walking with Him
- 5. Does one of those points resonate with you? How so?
 - · How is Jesus' resurrection impacting, challenging, or changing your life today/this week/in this season of your life?
 - Who can you tell about that?
