**Discussion Questions**

- 1. In this week's sermon, we saw 3 pleas from an aging pastor
  - A plea for love
  - o A plea for acceptance
  - A plea for obedience
    - How does this book relate to where we find ourselves in today's world?
    - Do you see any parallels to the Onesimus/Philemon relationship today? What about parallels to the Paul/Onesimus relationship?
- 2. This book brings to light how the Gospel reconciles people and transforms relationships.
  - Where do you need that Gospel work in your life?
  - What steps do you need to take this week toward greater love, acceptance, or obedience?
    - Can you be specific? For instance, with whom has your love fallen short, and what will you do to increase it?
    - Or, in what area of your life have you fallen short of obedience, and what will you do to begin obeying in that area?
  - When we consider the gaps in our love, acceptance and obedience, where does this book bring grace into focus?
- 3. Bonus material: This sermon (& the book of Philemon) brought up the idea of authority in the Church.
  - What has your experience been with authority in the Church?
  - Did that experience match with what Scripture teaches about it?
  - Is there anything (in action and/or attitude) that you need to bring into alignment with Scripture as it relates to authority in general?
