Exodus 25:8-9, 36:1 - Also: John 1:1-3, 14; Philippians 4:4-9; Romans 12:1-2; John 14:16-17; 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

Discussion Questions

What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scripture passages?

1. What imagery comes to mind when you think of God dwelling somewhere? Is your image more of a place? A person? Something else?
2. In the sermon the idea of trust was connected to worship. Look back over your life – how would you say you see that connection playing out? What could you do today to increase your level of trust in God?
3. How does thinking about, applying, and living in the truths He has revealed about Himself help you when it comes to dwelling in His presence?
4. Can you describe the connection between God dwelling with us, worship, and joy?
5. What does joy sound like?
6. How is your joy expressed? (In corporate worship? With your family? With the community of people where God has placed you?)
7. What about an ordinary day in your life leads you to worship? What about your day today has led you to worship? How do you celebrate those moments? Do you share them with people? Why or why not?
