**Discussion Questions** 

What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scripture in it?

- 1. Read Genesis 3:1-7
  - How is Adam and Eve's response a rejection of God's authority?
  - How/where do you see similar responses around you?
  - How/where do you see those kinds of responses in yourself?
- 2. Read the Matthew 4 and Matthew 3 passages noted above.
  - What are the conflicting messages Jesus is hearing?
- 3. In both examples (Genesis 3 and Matthew 4), the enemy presents his thought as a question rather than a statement.
  - What can we learn from that?
  - Do you think that's more or less powerful? Why?
- 4. In the sermon, multiple kinds of lies that the enemy tries to tell us were listed:
  - Can you ever be good enough?
  - o Aren't your identity and worth found in how much money you make?
  - Forgiveness is for everyone else, but is it really for you?
  - Don't you have to prove yourself to be loved?
  - What's the use, won't you always be the way you are?
  - No matter how hard you try, do you think you'll ever belong?
    - Are there other lies you would add to the list?
- 5. The short question is, what voice(s) are you listening to, and do you need to change it?

I pray, as we were challenged at the end of the sermon, that you'll make room for someone. Ask someone to share a meal together, ask them about their story, and listen! And share yours as well. Make room!
