- 1. What is a good working definition of mercy? (Have someone look it up if needed)
- 2. How many of you love patience? What is it about patience that makes it so hard?
- 3. How short is your fuse? Is it different in different situations? With different people?
- 4. If your ability to live patiently is different from person to person or situation to situation, what do you think makes it that way? (What factors influence your patience?)
- 5. In your life, how do you do with receiving the patience of others? (Is it hard for you when you make someone wait? Do you take their waiting for granted? Etc.)
- 6. How have you experienced Jesus' patience towards yourself?
- 7. Two significant points in the sermon:
 - The reality of a fallen world challenges what I thought what life was supposed to be like with God.
 - Thomas had to learn what he was going to have to live.
 - Ask yourself this question: "How does my expectation of ______ affect my ability to reflect the patience of Jesus?" (You can fill in the blank with "God" a person, a situation, etc.)
 - What truth do you have to learn that will help you live more freely in this realm?
- 8. Is the Spirit leading you toward repentance in some area today?
