Scripture:

Ephesians 2:1-10

Also: Lamentations 3:22-24; Titus 2:13; 1 Thessalonians 1:10; Philippians 3:20-21

Discussion Questions

What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scripture passages?

- 1. Read Ephesians 2:1-10. What do you find comforting in this passage? Encouraging? Offensive? Why?
- 2. What does verse one tell you about your past? About the past of others? What does it tell you about those around you who are not yet believers?
- 3. The first words of verse 4 (in the ESV) contain the pivotal words, "But God."
 - Really, our entire lives revolve around those words. We were one way before, then God intervened ("But God"), and now we are different after.
 - How would you describe your, "before," your "but God" moment, and your "after"?
- 4. The phrasing in verse 10 refers to believers as God's workmanship, or His masterpiece.
 - Do you view yourself that way? Why or why not? If not, how would changing that affect you?
 - Do you view other believers as God's masterpiece? How would changing that affect your relationships with other believers?
- 5. As you consider your spiritual life, where you came from, and your "but God" moment, what is one thing God is challenging you to change today?

May we walk in humility and thanksgiving with our great God who is rich in mercy and has great love for us!
