## **One Another - Week 1**

## Scripture:

John 13:34-35

Also: 1 John 4:7; Galatians 5:13-15; Ephesians 4:1-2; Romans 12:9-11; 1 Peter 5:14

## **Discussion Questions**

What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scripture passages?

- 1. Read John 13:34-35. What do you think about Jesus' commandment to love one another?
  - Is it fair of God to expect that of us?
  - What is the blend of obedience and feeling to look like? (Picture a husband giving his wife flowers only because it's his "duty" – is that really loving?)
  - How do you think our culture responds to Jesus' command to love?
- 2. In the sermon, several practical ways were discussed about how to show love:
  - By serving one another (read Galatians 5:13)
  - By bearing with one another (read Ephesians 4:1-2)
  - By being devoted to one another (read Romans 12:9-11)
  - o Do you find yourself resisting any of those ways of loving? Why?
  - $\circ~$  What do you find the most encouraging when you receive it?
  - What do you think is most impactful in our world? Why?
- **3.** Read 1 John 4:7 in the Living Bible, where it captures the idea of loving continually by using the phrasing "let us practice loving each other".
  - How does that phrasing shift your understanding of the passage?
  - o Do you think it's helpful?
  - Do you practice loving people?

Ask the God to give us the mind of Jesus, so that we may reflect Him for the world to see.
