## Scripture:

Matthew 28:16-20

## Also

Matthew 24:14; Luke 14:23; 2 Timothy 2:2; John 1:41-42

## Discussion Questions

What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scripture passages?

1. In this passage, Jesus mentions the word "all" three times:
  - All authority - **How does a recognition of Jesus' authority impact your view of reaching the lost?**
  - All Nations - **How does Jesus' indication to disciple all nations (from our neighbors to the nations, and everything in between) shift your role in His work?**
  - All Things - **What does Jesus' inclusion of teaching people to obey "all things" make you think about the current Church? About our church?**
2. In John 1:41-42, we see Andrew finding his brother Simon and bringing him to Jesus.
  - **What does "bringing someone to Jesus" mean? Is it preaching to them? Serving them? Giving them a Bible? Bringing them to a church service? Inviting them to your home? Giving them a tract?**
  - **What kinds of things have you done? (This isn't about bragging, but learning from each other!)**
  - **What have you found more/less effective?**
3. **If you wanted to take a step toward getting better at being a "3 Story Christian" as described in the sermon, which area would you need to work on?**
  - **Your story?**
  - **My Story?**
  - **Or God's Story? (Christ Crucified and Raised Again, Able to deliver all to a new life in Christ)**
4. **Where can you implement the "B.L.E.S.S." concept, 5 everyday ways to love your neighbor and change the world?**
  - *Begin with prayer*
  - *Listen*
  - *Eat*
  - *Serve*
  - *Story*
