## **Discussion Questions**

What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scripture passages?

- 1. In this passage, Jesus mentions the word "all" three times:
  - All authority How does a recognition of Jesus' authority impact your view of reaching the lost?
  - All Nations How does Jesus' indication to disciple all nations (from our neighbors to the nations, and everything in between) shift your role in His work?
  - All Things What does Jesus' inclusion of teaching people to obey "all things" make you think about the current Church? About our church?
- 2. In John 1:41-42, we see Andrew finding his brother Simon and bringing him to Jesus.
  - What does "bringing someone to Jesus" mean? Is it preaching to them? Serving them? Giving them a Bible? Bringing them to a church service? Inviting them to your home? Giving them a tract?
  - What kinds of things have you done? (This isn't about bragging, but learning from each other!)
  - What have you found more/less effective?
- 3. If you wanted to take a step toward getting better at being a "3 Story Christian" as described in the sermon, which area would you need to work on?
  - Your story?
  - My Story?
  - Or God's Story? (Christ Crucified and Raised Again, Able to deliver all to a new life in Christ)
- 4. Where can you implement the "B.L.E.S.S." concept, 5 everyday ways to love your neighbor and change the world?
  - Begin with prayer
  - Listen
  - ∘ *Eat*
  - Serve
  - Story
