Discussion Questions

- 1. What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scriptures in it?
- 2. How did Joseph keep going despite all of his setbacks, opposition & disaster?
 - When talking about a story like this from Scripture, how do you clarify the expectation (for yourself & others) that this kind of "prospering" really did happen for Joseph, but doesn't always happen for every God-follower?
 - What Scripture points you to your conclusion?
- 3. In the sermon, the point, "God was working behind the scenes" was made.
 - How do you think that would have helped Joseph?
 - Where do you need God to work in your life now?
 - o Do you trust that He is working "behind the scenes"?
 - Why or why not? And for either answer, how do you know that to be true?
- 4. What role have you seen forgiveness play in your life?
 - Have you ever seen a lack of forgiveness hold someone back? How?
 - o Is the Spirit nudging you to forgive someone right now?
 - o If yes, will you do it?
 - o If no, what is preventing you from doing it?
 - Take time to process the feelings around this!
 - Conclude by reading Matthew 6:14-15
