Discussion Questions

- 4. Forty-five years after the event occurred, Caleb remembered what had been promised and he held on to it. Read Hebrews 6:12, Ephesians 1:3, and 1 Peter 1:3-6 to see a couple of the promises/declarations about believers in Jesus.
 - o List as many promises/declarations as you can discern in these.
 - Does one resonate with you?
 - Is God reminding you of something in your life with one of these promises? If so, what/how is it connecting?
 - Are there other Scriptural promises you are finding helpful/needed right now, and if so, which ones, and why?
- 5. On a scale of 1-10, how bold are you when it comes to claiming God's promises?
 - o If there is room for improvement, why? Is something lacking in you?
