 - What are your enemies these days? (Illness, addiction, an estranged relationship, worry, crippling anxiety, bone crushing depression, grief, a job loss, a divorce, financial insecurity, pride, or personal insecurity? Something else?
- 3. Have you ever felt like God's given up on you, like you are too unworthy and that you're beyond His grace?
 - What does God's Word say about you?
 - Spend some time reading the Identity Scriptures above.
 - o Pick just one and meditate on it for a while.
 - o Perhaps...
 - Capture what you are thinking/feeling in a journal
 - Or tell someone about it
 - Or say/read one of the verses that resonates with you multiple times
 - Or memorize it
 - Or pray that you will believe and be reshaped by His truth
- 4. Have you ever been baptized?
 - If yes, great, maybe take time to tell a few stories that led to baptisms.
 - If not, do you have questions? (What are they?)
 - Would you consider doing it soon? (You can register at fcog.church and one of our pastors will get in touch with you)
