 - When is your "time of need"?
 - What are we to do at that time?
 - Why?
 - How does the truth of these verses impact your thinking about how God views someone who is being tempted?
- 7. Read Mark 10:45. How does the reality of Jesus' temptation affect His mission to serve and to save?
