Scripture: Mark 2:13-17

Questions

1. What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scriptures in it?
2. Read Mark 2:13-17
3. One quote mentioned is linked to Nikolaus Zinzendorf. The paraphrase version is - the call of the Christian is to live, preach the gospel, die, and be forgotten. How does that sit with you? Do you struggle with that thought? If you were to believe that, how would it change the way you live?
4. In a radical way Jesus invites Levi to come follow him. Mark 2:14 says, "and Levi got up and followed Him." In a brief way, what did it look like for you in your life to "get up and follow Him?"
5. An old illustration used to describe what it means to follow Jesus is to follow Him so closely or to sit at His feet so that you are covered in the dust of his feet. In Luke 10:39 Mary sat at Jesus feet and listened to what he said. What are some ways we can be covered in the dust of Jesus?
6. Jesus says in Mark 2:17 - "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners." What are some ways that you as an individual or our church as a whole can live out this truth that the sick need a doctor - that all people need Jesus?
