Scripture: Mark 10:1-12

Also: Mark 10:45; Deuteronomy 24; Deuteronomy 6:4; John 17:20-21

Questions

- 1. What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scriptures in it?
- 2. Read Mark 10: 1-12.
- 3. The Pharisees often seemed to live in a way where they looked for the loophole in God's law.
 - How do you see that (looking for loopholes) in past Christianity (somewhere between today and Jesus' day)?
 - What about in modern day Christianity, or in your own life?
- 4. The point was made that, "sinfulness is always connected to chaos and confusion."
 - In what ways do you feel the weight of that chaos and confusion?
 - Where do you see it in our culture?
- 5. The follow-up point was that "The way of Jesus brings clarity to confusion and chaos.â€
 - Where do you need Jesus' clarity in your life today?
- 6. How did your understanding of "the two [in marriage] shall become one flesh" grow from studying this passage?
 - How did it stay the same?
 - o If married, what can you do this week to live in the oneness that Christ designed for marriage?
 - Read John 17:20-21.
 - o For everyone, what can you do this week to live in the oneness Christ designed for His Church?
 - Married or single, do you think your view of marriage aligns with Jesus' teaching? Why or why not?
- 7. The final point was that "The Way of Jesus is the best way to live."
 - What would you say to someone who disagrees with that?
 - Do you think there is a right and wrong to that statement, or does everyone get their equally valid opinion?
- What questions does this passage, or this sermon leave you with?
