Scripture: Mark 10:46-52

Questions

1. Read Mark 10:46-52
2. What has challenged you or changed you from this week's sermon or the Scriptures in it?
3. What questions do you have or where do you want to dig in a little deeper?
4. After reading through the scripture passage for this week, how would you answer the question - "If Jesus were passing by today, how would you respond?"
5. Blind Bart saw himself - in many ways he understood his need for a Savior. Why do you think it's so hard for us to truly see ourselves and our need for a Savior?
6. Blind Bart saw Jesus and understood him as Savior. There are times in our lives when we become our own savior. If you are comfortable sharing - what are some ways we "save" ourselves, when we are stressed, or in need, or stuck in our sin?
7. Blind Bart saw his opportunity. What keeps you from crying out to Jesus?
8. Mark 10:49 says - And Jesus stopped and said, "Call him." And they called the blind man, saying to him, "Take heart. Get up; he is calling you." While we certainly have the responsibility to call out to Jesus as our Savior, spend some time at the end of your group time praying for one another and thanking God that he calls us.
