Questions

1. Read Luke 1:5-25.
2. With the Christmas Story being familiar, did anything stand out in a different way in today's scripture?
3. When would you view the statement from God to "Fear Not" as a command to "Stop it" rather than a promise to believe that God is doing something beautiful in your life?
4. What do you think a beautiful life that God is writing and creating looks like?
5. Has someone's beautiful story in the midst of rough circumstances come to mind who inspired you in your faith? If so, share with the group.
6. Why does someone's faith story inspire you more knowing they overcame fears and doubts?
7. In the Book of Genesis, Joseph makes the following statement: "As for you, you meant it for evil against me, but God meant it for good" Genesis 50:20. Share a story in your life where harm was meant against you, but God turned it for good, even beautiful.
8. What other verses have helped you when facing fearful situations or suffering?
9. What keeps you from expressing your fears and doubts to other believers?
10. Take a few minutes to share any fears or doubts you might have and pray for each other knowing we can trust God with those fears.
